

Dear Saint Matthew Community and Visitors:

This weekend we have the opportunity to acknowledge and thank John Riehle. For the past five years John has been Pastoral Administrator for the Church of Saint Matthew. When John joined us he promised that when his youngest child graduated from college he would be leaving Saint Matthew's. Chuck graduated this year, so John is leaving — if John is anything, he is true to his word.

We owe a profound debt of gratitude to John for his ministry. He is multi-talented and among the many things he did for and with us are the following:

He initiated an annual stewardship effort that increased parish collections by more than \$100,000.

Under his direction and negotiations the annual subsidy for Saint Matthew's School from the Archdiocese rose from \$45,000 to \$160,000.

John oversaw the renovation of our worship space — new sanctuary, carpeting, sound system, stained glass windows, etc.

During the past year John also served as director of our Religious Education and Formation Program and Sacramental preparation program.

Five years ago John served as choir and music director for six months until we were able to hire Dana McCarthy.

On a daily basis John coordinated the work of the various directors of ministry — liturgical, educational, maintenance, food service, pastoral ministry and business administration.
